

CRITERIA FOR INDIVIDUAL CEB AWARDS



FEDERATION OF THE YEAR

- The federation must have been active, during the past year, in organizing courses/clinics for its members and/or players and/or umpires and/or scorers and/or coaches.
- The federation must have been active, during the past year, in organizing international tournament/s or development courses or clinics.
- The federation has to evidence meaningful growth in membership, during the past year.
- The federation has to evidence meaningful growth in the number of baseball clubs/teams during the past year.
- The federation has to maintain on-going contact with the CEB office and officers and committees (by responding promptly to questionnaires/inquiries and providing updated contact information).
- The federation has to participate in CEB Congresses and related development workshops and meetings.
- The federation has to have a well designed website with up-to-date information.
- The Federation should evidence an interest in assisting fellow CEB member federations in their baseball development activities.
- The Federation should evidence an interest in offering suggestions to the CEB EC/DC for workshops at the CEB congress and/or for improvements in CEB operations.
- The Federation should not currently be in arrears in its financial obligations to CEB nor have a recent past record of meaningful debt to CEB.

Note: A Federation is not permitted to nominate itself for the Federation of the Year award

Nominations should include:

1. Name and official address of the Federation being nominated
2. Name, address, email address and phone number information of the nominating party
3. Detailed description/information evidencing full compliance, by the Federation being nominated, with all of the required criteria for nomination
