

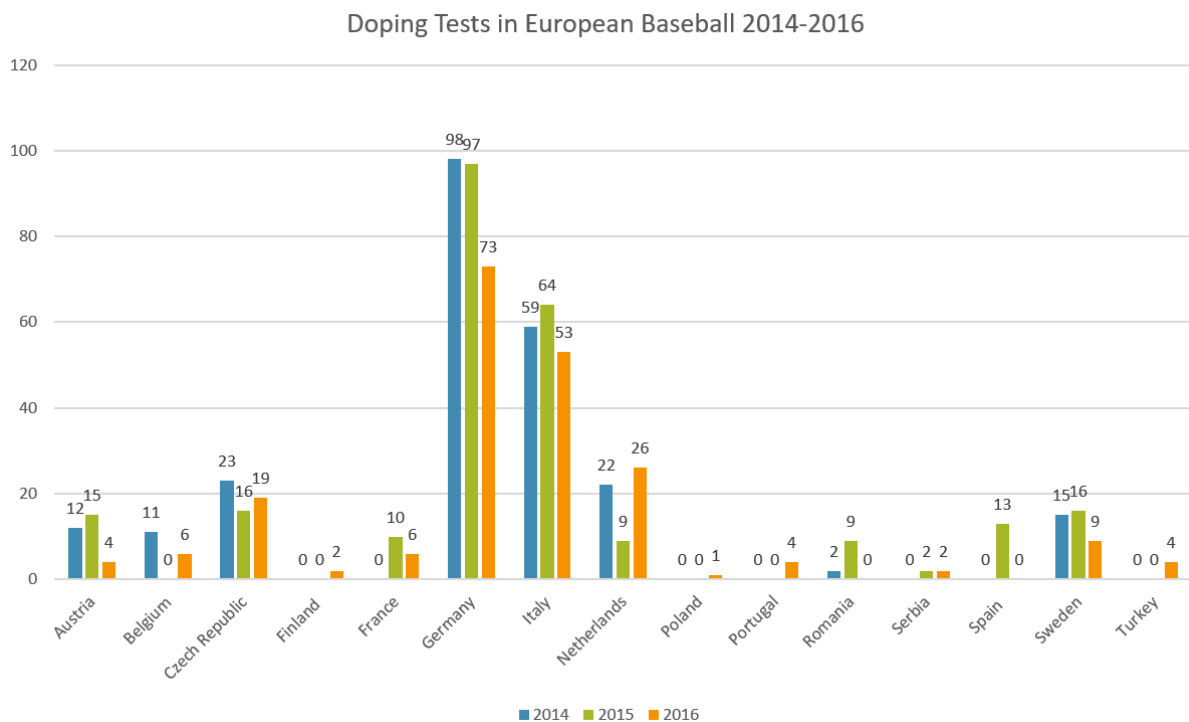
PRESS RELEASE – WADA 2014-2016 TESTING FIGURES

The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) has released the testing figures for 2016. Worldwide, 1016 baseball samples (996 urine and 20 blood) were collected and analyzed in accordance with the Code and its Standards. The number of samples for 2015 was 1538 (1453 urine and 85 blood).

In European baseball, 205 samples (199 urine and 3 blood) were collected and analyzed. The number of samples for 2015 were 236 samples (229 urine and 7 blood).

See attached graph for the distribution of tests carried out per country over the past three years. A total of 671 baseball players in 15 of 38 CEB member countries have been tested over the last three years (230 in 2014; 236 in 2015; 205 in 2016).

CEB has collected a total of 33 samples in its tournaments over the same time period (8 in 2014; 8 in 2015; 14 in 2016).
